## MALALA YOUSAFZAI

MALALA YOUSAFZAI was born on 12<sup>th</sup> July 1997 to Zia Uddin Yousafzai and Toor Pekai Yousafzai .She is a human rights activist and is known for empowering women education She received the Nobel peace prize in 2014 when she was just 17 years old which makes her the youngest Nobel prize laureate of all time .She protested against the Taliban which was a terrorist organization operating within Swat Valley ,Pakistan.

The Taliban at times had banned girls from attending school. On 9<sup>th</sup> October 2012 when she was travelling by bus with two of his friends she was shot in the head by a Taliban gunman who fled the scene .She remained in a critical condition for a long time ,in the Rawalpindi institute of cardiology but her condition later improved and she was shifted to the Queen Elizabeth hospital in Birmingham ,UK .

The attempt of her life sparked an international outpouring of support for Malala. In 2013 she co-authored a book named I am Malala .The time magazine has featured her as one of the most influential people in the world .Malala's quest for world peace is continued by many around the world.


The man was amazed after listening to this. Dear children, like the elephants, how many of us going through the life believing we cannot do something just because we failed at it at once?

## From the corner of Art and design

### Art of Doodling:

Doodling is a great, fun way of expressing yourself. A **doodle** is a drawing made while a person's attention is otherwise occupied. Doodles are simple drawings that can have concrete representational meaning or may just be composed of random and abstract lines, generally without ever lifting the drawing device from the paper. Doodle art can help you learn how to draw and make a great addition to your design portfolio. London-based artist and illustrator Hattie Stewart is the undisputed queen of doodle art. She's famous for her unique graphic style, iconic cover takeovers and client work with – amongst others – Adidas and Apple .

Effects on memory : According to a study published in the scientific journal *Applied Cognitive Psychology*, doodling can aid a person's memory by expending just enough energy to keep one from daydreaming, which demands a lot of the brain's processing power, as well as from not paying attention. Nobel laureate (in literature, 1913) poet Rabindranath Tagore made huge number of doodles in his manuscript. Poet and physician John Keats doodled in the margins of his medical notes; other literary doodlers have included Samuel Beckett and Sylvia Plath. Many American Presidents, including Thomas Jefferson, Ronald Reagan, and Bill Clinton, have been known to doodle during meetings.
